

Wiltshire Rural Business Mentoring Programme - Highlights

The Wiltshire Rural Business Mentoring Programme commenced in September 2006 and ran until the end of March 2009. The target market was small to medium sized enterprise businesses based in rural Wiltshire.

Rural Business Mentoring Programme

As the credit crunch hit towards the end of 2008 responses to the marketing picked up momentum and as time began to run out we found we had a number of applications that we could not process before the end of the programme. We continue to receive calls enquiring about the service and believe this is evidence that there is a continuing need for this support mechanism.

Feedback

From verbal feedback clients felt the free mentoring was a valuable programme and they were appreciative of the opportunity this gave them to advance their businesses. Before the end of the programme a feedback form was issued – 10 of the 20 clients responded (50%).
